





Great Backyard Bird Count! - February 20, 2022

Each year people from around the world come together to watch, learn about, count, and celebrate birds! We will head off on trails to count birds and report our sightings online at birdcount.org. Anyone can take part in the Great Backyard Bird Count, from beginning bird watchers to experts. Each checklist submitted during the GBBC helps researchers at the National Audubon Society, Cornell Lab of Ornithology and Birds Canada learn more about how birds are doing and how to protect them and the environment we share. You will be part of creating the largest instantaneous snapshot of global bird populations scientists can have! We'll have a Bird Expert on site to help with identifications.



Frequently Asked Questions

What are the requirements for Climb + Zipline?

To be able to experience our Climb + Zipline Adventure Course, we do require participants to be a minimum of 70 lbs and 52 inches and a maximum of 250 lbs and 6 foot 6 inches. We also require that any participant 13 years and younger have an accompanying adult up on the course with them.

Are reservations required to visit the park?

Reservations are recommended to guarantee availability for your adventure. However, walk-up reservations may be possible as long as we have availability.

Is there a fee to enter the park? Do you charge for parking?

There are no entrance or parking fees at The Forge: Lemont Quarries. Anyone can come to the park and walk or bike on our public trails or just people-watch! You only pay for activities like climbing, ziplining, laser tag, boating, etc.

What should I wear?

We are an outdoor park, so please dress for the weather. We recommend comfortable clothing and shoes as you will be moving around a lot! Closed-toe, no-slip shoes are required when climbing. Crocs or sandals with straps are not acceptable to climb in.

Do you serve food?

Our on-site restaurant, The Foundry, has grab-and-go food, snacks, and beverages year-round. During the winter months, we have Globe Dining with a rotating weekly menu created by our in-house chef. In the summer, we have Forgefire Adventure Dining each weekend.
